

## Simple Ribbed Poppy

Use DK poppy red yarn and no 10, 3.25 or 3.5mm needles, these are smaller sizes than usual. Or use 4ply poppy red yarn and no 10, 11, 2.75 or 3mm needles.

Cast on 60 sts

Rows 1-10 K2P2

Row 11 K2 together across the row (30sts)

Row 12 (Slip 1 K2 together, pass the slip stitch over) to end (10sts)

Break off yarn leaving a long end, thread on a sewing needle and pass yarn through the 10 sts. Pull tightly into a circle, fasten securely and then use yarn to stitch edges together.

Sew a black button in the middle.
